Elder Lorren Godwin preached "Watching While Others Do" from II Samuel 6:14-16. The church has some who are spectators, yet we all ought to be participators. King David had great respect for the Ark of the Covenant (symbol of the presence of God). As he was bringing the Ark back to Jerusalem he leaped and danced before the Lord with joy. We ought to worship God demonstratively, whether by shouting, jumping, dancing, etc. Someone may sit and stare at us and think we're demeaning ourselves, yet we're enjoying in the presence of God. We must respect the presence of God. We must have a personal relationship with Jesus Christ and be more concerned about celebrating the presence of God than about what people think of us. Some allow others' opinions to change them. Yet if we truly fall in love with Jesus, those opinions won't sway us. Pursue a relationship with Jesus. Tell others about the love of God. Be a "doer" not just a "watcher."

Pastor Joseph preached "Down, But Not Out! From Micah 7:8. Hell has thrown its best shots at us, yet we're still here! If your situation looks bad, you ought to look the devil in the eye and say, "I may be down, but I'm not out!" Greater is He that is in me then he that is in the world! When we are water baptized in Jesus name and filled with the Holy Ghost, we are wearing the name of Jesus. We are wearing the righteousness of the Lord Jesus Christ. There's something powerful in determining that although I may slip and fall, still we have the ability to get back up. When the devil puts thoughts in your mind, such as that people/church don't love you and are against you, you need to gird up the loins of your mind and bring every thought into captivity. Say to yourself, "Stop thinking those thoughts." You need to protect your thought life. Pray! The devil would love for you to get discouraged, but keep witnessing and faithfully attending church. "Let us not be weary in well doing, for in due season we shall reap if we faint not."

Wednesday



Live your life so that your moderation testifies to the fact that you trust God in all aspects of life. Don't lose sleep over worrying about tomorrow. Showing moderation in all things is wise. Display your confidence in God by not over-working yourself, by having proper diet, regular sleep routine, moderation in exercise, family schedule, church attendance, prayer, fasting, and all other occasions. Be consistent in all things. Just keep on praying and keep on trusting God for your daily bread. Don't give up and backslide, but rather hold fast onto God, because one day He's going to make everything right. Trust Him!




