Sunday AM – Survey of the Book of Acts, chapter 19

Pastor Joseph preached "A Tale of Two Idols" from Acts 19:35-36. God's timing is not ours. He does perform miracles, but sometimes He says "no" or "wait." Sometimes God gives us physical healing—yet sometimes He doesn't. Are you still faithful to trust God when He says no? The power of the name of Jesus comes through having a relationship with God. When the sons of Sceva tried to cast out devils by Jesus name, they couldn't because they did not know Jesus. In Ephesus the people worshipped a so-called goddess, Artemis (Gr.) / Diana (Latin). During a mighty revival in the region, many turned away from worshipping her and ceased buying silver trinkets of her image. Thus the people were being converted, but the artisans who sold trinkets related to Diana were not making as much money. These men didn't care whether Jesus was real or not. All they cared about was their money. This was their real idol, and that is, the love of money. "For the love of money is the root of all evil" (I Timothy 6:10). Seek after truth more than wealth!

Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached "Garment of Praise" from Isaiah 60:18-19 & 61:3. God is great and greatly to be praised. He's always deserving of our greatest praise to His name even if we are weak in body or don't feel positive. We ought to always praise Him. There is something powerful about stepping out of your circumstance and determining within yourself that you are going to praise God. You can praise your way out of situations. As you praise, by clapping/raising your hands, shouting, and dancing unto the Lord, chains will fall off, even some you are not able to pray yourself out of. God can take away depression or oppression and give you a garment of praise for a garment of heaviness. It's not natural weapons that help us when we're in a spiritual battle. It's when we lift our hands and praise God. When you go into spiritual warfare, you need to begin a time of intercessory prayer starting with a prayer of worship and praise. "**Be the man.**" Praise God!

Elder Zach Sandy preached "Finding Purpose in the Process" from Matthew 8:23-27. Nothing can compare to a life sold out to God. When you're living a life sold out to God, life is blessed because you have the favor of God. When you're living your life sold out to God, you're living for God with all you have—your finances, thoughts, every word you speak, and in all other aspects of your life. It takes daily prayer, Bible study, fasting and devotion. Storms will come in your life but you will stand because you are built upon a rock. Through our storms God will be with us. Our minds can't comprehend what God is doing. In order for rain to fall, there must also be cloudiness. You can't have a **test**imony without first facing the **test**. There's always a purpose in the process. You may not find it until years later, but there was a reason for what happened. God is with you through any storm in your life. When He speaks the storm has to obey him. Trust God!
