Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached "Beholding the Glory of God" from Isaiah 40:3-5, bringing four points about God's glory revealed in Jesus. (1) God has used various means to reveal Himself to mankind; however, we have the supreme revelation of the glory of God in the incarnation in Jesus Christ. (2) God reveals Himself through His Word (Greek: "logos"), which is God's very thoughts, His plan, His mind. His self-expression. His self-revelation. His Word is involved in His active power. The Lord's plan and methods are better than anything that a man can devise. God's Word is alive and powerful and sharper than any two-edged sword and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart. (3) God's glory was revealed to Moses in the tabernacle and to Jews in the temple, but later God was ultimately "tabernacled" in Jesus (John 1:1,14). (4) God's glory is revealed supremely in Jesus Christ. Jesus is the incarnate Word of God. He is the very expression of God revealing Himself in flesh. One ought not try to separate God's thoughts from God Himself. "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God" (John 1:1). "And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt [tabernacled] among us, (and we beheld his glory)" (John 1:14). God's Word and glory are revealed to us in the tabernacle of Christ's flesh. God may sometimes allow your life to be full of great trials, but it is so that the light of the glorious gospel can shine out through you. Believers' bodies are now the tabernacles of God. The Lord is good and His mercy endureth forever.

Wednesday

Elder Zach Sandy preached "It's Time to Make a Statement" from I Samuel 17:45. One can make a statement, inspiring others, whether by actually declaring (speech) or even without verbal speech. "Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen" (Hebrews 11:1). Your faith can determine the outcome of a situation. The way you respond to adversity is going to determine what happens. The enemy will try to crush us when we're feeling down, but it's then that we must stand up and make a statement. There is power when you speak faith into your situation. Make a statement by faith in the midst of a tragedy.
