Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph preached "A Day of New Beginnings" from Joshua 3:3-4. In the Old Testament God chose a rock for Moses to use for a miracle of giving water. That rock was a prophetic foreshadowing of Jesus Christ. He is the rock upon which the Church is built and from Him living water flows. Moses smiting the rock was a foreshadowing of the crucifixion. Moses sinned by smiting the rock a second time. That did not fit the prophecy, as Jesus was only to be under death's touch once. Death will never again have power over Him. Jesus Christ will always and for all eternity be the human manifestation of God. The Son of God will not cease to exist. God will always have the man Jesus as His human manifestation. Moses gave a spiritual surname to his second-in-command, naming him Joshua (Hebrew to English), which means "Yahweh (God) saves" or "God is Saviour" or "God is Salvation." That same name was given to Jesus (Hebrew to Aramaic to Greek to Latin to English). Satan is a master of disguise and deceit. By the power of suggestion he will try to instill fear in you. As a child of God you don't have to live a life of fear. When you say the name Jesus, you're saying the name of God the Father (the name means "Yahweh-Savior"). In the New Covenant, water baptism is circumcision made without hands. Physical circumcision is a symbolic pointer telling us how utterly necessary and essential is baptism in the name of Jesus. It is our token of citizenship in the Kingdom of God. The scarlet cord that was agreed upon for the woman who helped the Hebrew spies was a symbol of the blood of Jesus. The blood of Jesus is applied to us when we repent, are baptized in His name, and receive the Holy Ghost. There is no sin so deep that the blood can't reach it. We are living in a day of new beginnings. Let us be instruments in His hand as never before.

Elder Baron Claypool preached "Still Standing" from I Samuel 17:49-51. When Goliath defied the armies of the living God, David was the only one who would stand in the face of the enemy. Whom do we serve – the one true God or "Jehovah Junior"? Are we willing to stand for what we believe in? David believed in his God, and he chose to stand and face the enemy no matter the outcome. The stone didn't kill Goliath. It just stunned him. David took Goliath's sword and slew him. If we just stun the devil when he attacks us, our problems will never go away. We need to attack and slay our problem. We must stand in the face of the enemy and say "no more." Put the enemy under our feet and leave him there. If we are going through a battle, we have to let the enemy know that we are going to stand no matter what he brings against us. "Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all to stand" (Ephesians 6:13).

Elder Rusty Sandy preached "It's Not Going To End Like This" from Matthew 8:23-26. God is the author and finisher of our faith. You may be the midst of a storm or a sickness, or you may be struggling in a situation, but it doesn't have to end in disaster. God can step into any situation and say, "Peace, be still." Our faith is a strong anchor, and it's anchored in the arms of Jesus. Through situations and circumstances in our life, we need to look through the eyes of God and know it's not going to end like this.
