#### Sunday AM

Elder Lorren Godwin preached "What's My Attitude?" from Genesis 29:30-35. When we get our attitude right and begin to praise the Lord in spite of all the setbacks and pain we've experienced in life then God can use that and will bless us. Our attitude in our trials determines our outcome. Job was a man who had everything. One day he lost it all – his children, his wealth, all of his animals. He lost everything. But he said, "the Lord gave, and the Lord hath taken away; blessed be the name of the Lord" (Job 1:21). His friends accused him of sinning. Yet, when he prayed for them God blessed him with twice what he had before. When you're laying sick in bed or when you're going through a bad trial or situation you need to praise and worship the Lord. When Paul and Silas were arrested and cast into prison they didn't grumble and complain. They prayed and sang praises to God and they were set free. It wasn't because they deserved it. It was because they had an attitude of worship and praise. During the midst of our most painful and troubled trial we need to praise and worship God for Who He is. Choose to live a lifestyle of worship!

Elder Baron Claypool preached "Family Traditions" from Genesis 12:1-3. Families have different traditions - some are good and some are not good. We are all part of the family of God. It's imperative that we develop our own sense of tradition. We have to be careful to protect the heritage that has to be handed down to us. Be careful to not let those things slip that have been taught unto us. There is nothing more important in your walk with God than separation. It's separation from the world that will keep us close to God. We can't be a friend to the world and a friend to God at the same time. We have to have a sense in ourselves that we're going to let your light shine all the time no matter the circumstance. We must be sure we grasp a spirit of sacrifice and a spirit of prayer. A person with a close relationship with God has a prayer life. We must hear and obey the voice of God. We must communicate with Him and have a close relationship with Him. We must, like Abraham did, teach our children the laws of God. Develop this tradition in your children so that your children's children will also know God's laws. Teach our children that God is first in our lives. We need a family tradition in our personal lives and in our church family that we are going to work for God.
