Pastor Joseph preached "The Man in the Middle" from Ezekiel 1:1-28, and other verses. The Lord God Almighty declared, "Beside me there is no Savior" (Isaiah 43:11) and "My glory will I not give to another" (Isaiah 42:8). God does not have or allow some other divine being to sit beside Him as Savior, but He does have Himself in a man, who is in Him! "For in him [Christ] dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily" (Colossians 2:9, KJV) "For in Christ all the fullness of the Deity lives in bodily form" (Colossians 2:9, NIV). God devised for an ark to be built during the time of Moses, upon which God's glory would rest, and He told Moses to have the artisans craft two golden angels (cherubim) to be on it, facing toward the center. "There, above the cover between the two cherubim that are over the ark of the covenant law, I will meet with you and give you all my commands for the Israelites" (Exodus 25:22, NIV). The two angels faced one another, but in between, in the middle, where their gaze met, was the glory of God! What was this a picture of? The mercy seat where the blood of the pure sacrifice was offered is symbolic of the burial slab upon which Jesus' dead body was laid in a borrowed tomb! It also eventually had two angels on it: "And seeth two angels in white sitting, the one at the head, and the other at the feet, where the body of Jesus had lain" (John 20:12). Repentant believers can enter into the tom with Him: "We are buried with him by baptism..." (Romans 6:4). "Buried with him in baptism, wherein also ye are risen with him through the faith of the operation of God, who hath raised him from the dead" (Colossians 2:10-12). We as repentant, baptized believers, have passed through the tomb with Him. However, He's no longer there, so we're not still there. We're with Him, yet He's still in the middle of us all! Let us bind together in unity and love, with our gaze meeting in the middle, on the man in the midst of the Glory of God!

Elder Rusty Sandy preached "Every Student Matters" from Galatians 3:28. It doesn't matter whether you are black or white, or male or female, we are all part of the family of God. We shouldn't treat people differently because of their past or their skin color or any other ethnic distinctive. We all matter to God. 

Pro-Life Legislative Update:

CAC was well represented at the annual Pro-Life Rally and Day at the Capital February 5, 2018. CAC's own Pastor Doug Joseph was asked to address the crowd and encourage donations, just prior to receiving an offering for WV For Life. This year's two legislative goals of WV For Life were presented to elected officials along with throusands of signatures. Since then, you helped us press the WV Senate (by calls and emails) to pass SJR 12, for a constitutional amendment that would enable blocking taxpayer funding of abortion in WV. Your calls and emails worked! The Senate passed SJR 12 by a vote of 25-9. Now we need to reach out to the WV House of Delegates about SJR 12, just like we did the Senate. Hopefully the House will pass SJR 12 too, and then in the next election cycle, the people of West Virginia will have a chance to ratify the amendment.
