Elder Lorren Godwin preached "The Shape of Water" from Genesis 49:3-4 & Ephesians 4:12-14. Our words are true indicators of our feelings. They reveal who we are. The world is listening to us as we speak. There is so much negativity in this world. We should always speak positive and pray about our problems. Be very careful of your words because they paint a picture of your soul. We are to be an example of Jesus Christ. "For by thy words thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned" (Matthew 12:37). We have to check our attitude. It is said that talk is cheap, however, talk can be very detrimental. If we talk about negative things and talk about our bothers/sisters in the Lord, what kind of reflection of Jesus Christ is that? We must teach the young children what we believe in. Show them scriptures in the Bible until they see the truth themselves. Water is probably the most formable thing in God's creation. As water hits the ground it changes its form. Be very careful of your words, and keep your mind and your thoughts centered on God, so you won't be as unstable as water.

Pastor Joseph preached "Gift from Heaven: Some Assembly Required" from Genesis 35:5. Children are a gift from Heaven. "Lo, children are an heritage of the Lord: and the fruit of the womb is his reward" (Psalm 127:3). Children are not born with sin guilt, but all of us were born with a sin curse.
