Sunday AM-(Continuation of the study of the book of Acts)

Pastor Joseph preached "Paul's Farewell" from Acts 20:36-38. After the horrific uproar in Ephesus Paul continued travelling giving exhortation to the people. There were Jewish people who believed the Jewish prophecies of Messiah and saw in this man Jesus the fulfillment of them. But there were some Jews who had misperceptions or ignorance of the prophecies. Many Jews received Jesus as the Son of God and as God manifested in the flesh. There were Jews who would not welcome the Gentile people into the church. This caused tremendous friction among the Jewish people. But Paul preached to them that God had made a way for them to be people of faith, to have God's Spirit in their hearts and for them to live in a manner of righteousness. The Jewish people have been persecuted and hated for years. Paul is making his farewell address to the church elders at Ephesus. He had been the church planter there. He reminded them of the times he had been with them and preached unto them repentance in the name of Jesus Christ. And now he was going bound to Jerusalem knowing that persecution was awaiting him. But he counted that as precious to the Lord to suffer for him. We are working for the Kingdom of God.

Sunday PM

Our guest missionary preached a powerful message on faith, while telling amazing miracles that God is doing to reach Islamic people in the Middle East. The missionary exhorted us to do more than just "hope" for a better circumstance "tomorrow," challenging us to instead have faith in The Great "I AM" (not just the "I WILL BE" but the "I AM") for a miraculous touch and help in the here and now. God's word declares, "Behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation" (II Corinthians 6:2). Trusting God for the miraculous can lead to unprecedented blessings. Just as the woman who touched the hem of Jesus' garment (for healing of a hemorrhage) had no Scripture verse telling her that could work, so also a mute person (who came into one of their services), in addition to being healed so that she could speak, and also being baptized in Jesus name and filled with the Holy Ghost, was miraculously made permanently able to speak two languages she had never learned, while simply walking home from the home-group church service (and now serves as a minister and church planter) with no verses of Scripture indicating such a thing should be expected. Trust God, not your circumstances!

Wednesday

Jr. Elder JT Sandy preached "Left is Right" from Romans 12:2. We are not called to be normal. We are not called to blend in with our surroundings. We need to *stick out* when we go to school, work, or wherever. "Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord" (II Corinthians 6:17). If we aren't separated from the world He will not receive us. We must be what this world considers abnormal or weird. There's nothing better than dedication to God.

Elder Brian Murphy Jr. preached "Jesus is The Answer" from Acts 9. There is power in the name of Jesus. A woman with an incurable disease spent all her money trying to be healed, but when she reached out to Jesus her life was changed. God spoke to Paul who had persecuted the church, and God made of him a great apostle who preached God's Word. Jesus commanded the sea to be still when the disciples were in the boat. Jesus was the answer for them, and He is also the answer for any problem that is in your life.


