Faith is complete trust in something; it's being sold out to what you believe in. Temperance is self-control. We must be meek and not act like we are better than others. We cannot operate effectively in the spiritual realm if our fruit is rotten. It affects our mindset and our heart. What does your fruit look like? It is shown forth in our words and actions. Show Jesus to a world that is broken.

Pastor Joseph preached "Friend" from II Timothy 4:6-12. True friendship is such a treasure. As the Apostle Paul journeyed from place to place he had many friends, ministers who were willing to stop whatever they were doing and accompany him on his mission trips and be available to serve in new churches. Luke, the writer of the Gospel bearing his name and also of the Book of Acts, journeyed with Paul and even stayed with him while Paul was incarcerated. He devoted his life to ministry in friendship with Paul. If the Lord tarries, we're all going to pass on some day. Few things in life are truly eternal. The church and your friendships in the church will last forever. The church is truly a brotherhood and a sisterhood. There's nothing more valuable than a faithful saint of God. "There is a friend that sticketh closer than a brother" (Proverbs 18:24a). That friend is Jesus.

Wednesday

Rabbi Pesach Wolicki lectured from Psalm 19 on "Paganism vs. God's Law." Studying Scripture is a form of worship. This unusual Psalm has three distinct sections: (1) nature's "wordless" testimony of a higher power (and without a direct Word from the God who made the sun, mankind would tend to become pagan sun worshippers), (2) God's law (Word from the Creator, raising us out of paganism), and (3) intimate relationship with God, praying for His help in our lives so we may serve Him and be pleasing to Him. The Lord is the Chief Musician i.e. Cosmic Conductor. God has many different names, each describing different aspects of His. God's law is perfect, transforming the soul, bringing us order in a chaotic fallen world. God cares about us and brings us joy and wisdom. He enlightens us, opening our minds and souls. His law helps us interact externally (with others), and internally (enhancing our inner experience). It's like gold (of external value);

and it's like honey (internal value). Verse 14 says, "Let the words of my mouth," [when I interact with others], "and the meditation of my heart," [inner experience] "be acceptable in thy sight, O LORD" In Genesis, God asked two key questions about sin: "Where are you?" (internal) and "Where is your brother?" (external).
