Sunday AM – Continuation of our Survey of the Book of Acts

Pastor Joseph preached, “Appeal to Caesar, Part 1” from Acts 24:1-9. When Paul was taken to a Roman court before Felix, a prosecuting attorney for the Sanhedrin grossly misrepresented the facts of the case. Their spokesman was not an eyewitness to anything Paul was accused of. He was chosen to prosecute Paul because he had a reputation for speaking well. He had heard only one side of the story and was trying to press the matter, yet the Bible teaches that it’s folly to answer a matter before hearing it. Furthermore, the Sanhedrin brought no witnesses! That was clearly against the Mosaic (Jewish) law. Our western judicial code’s best aspects are based on Mosaic law, including that a person has a right to face their accusers, witnesses ought to be required, and that a person is presumed innocent until proven guilty. Furthermore, Mosaic law has a principle called (in Latin) “Lex Talionis” (Law of Retaliation), which basically teaches us to “Let the punishment fit the crime.” While some matters must be litigated, not all matters should be. Jesus said, “Blessed are the peacemakers.” A person who is not a peacemaker will prosecute even when they have no grounds or basis to prosecute. A person who is a peacemaker will avoid prosecuting if they can. A church family must have unity and maturity. We must strive to get along with each other.

Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached “My Father, My Father” from II Kings 2:11-14. We need to have a holy backbone and stand for the things of God. When we cry “My Father, My Father” (twice), we could let one of them be a reference to our father in the gospel while letting the other one be a reference to our Heavenly Father, God. Although our *father figure* may be taken from this world, we must stay connected to God. Fatherhood is about taking responsibility, to love and care for someone enough to teach them the truth. Whether God blesses you with miracles or not, you have the Word of God and you need to stand on it. Don’t chase after signs. Build your life on the Word of God. Talk, walk, act, think, and dress like the Word of God instructs. Before the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus Christ, believers who died in faith went down to a place of paradise in the Abode of the Dead. Now they go up with the Lord. Keep your eyes upon on Jesus. He will never leave you.

Wednesday

Elder Hannah Sandy preached “Changing The Frame” from Acts 3:19. True repentance is genuinely turning from sin, not just saying you’re “sorry.” Changing our behavior is so difficult. It’s not easy to change the way you talk, act, dress, and think – your whole pattern of living. It has been instilled in you. Only God can give you the power to truly change. You must **resist** things the devil puts before your eyes that you used to do. You have to learn to stop engaging in that behavior. The more often you do this, the easier it becomes. It’s the same way in our spiritual life with prayer and fasting. The more we do it the easier it becomes.
