Saturday PM – Bilingual Revival Service

Pastor Pedro Guizar preached “How Long Has it Been?” from John 5:1-8. Jesus went to the Pool of Bethesda, where lame/impotent folk traditionally laid waiting for an angel to trouble the waters, and whoever was first into the waters would be healed. Jesus found a lame man who had lain there for 38 years! When Jesus asked if he wanted to be healed, instead of saying yes, he gave an excuse! The Lord is here to heal, so don't make an excuse, have faith and receive! How long has it been since you let God touch you? (God moved powerfully in this service!)

Sunday AM – Bilingual Revival Service

Evangelist Marvin Rodriguez preached “The Power of An Experience with God” from Acts 1:8. Jesus told His followers to tarry in Jerusalem until they would be endued with power from on high. We need to have an experience with God! We can come in sad yet leave joyous; come sick yet leave healed; come destroyed yet leave restored! We can't have someone else's experience with God—we each need our own personal relationship with God. There is no power or anointing without it. We need to have a supernatural experience with God. There needs to be a fire within us that makes us to raise our hands and clap our hands in praise to God! Let's awaken and see the suffering of lost souls. Let's do more praying and fasting. We need the fire of God in our lives! Let's have the experience in God that He wants to give us! Have a connection of our heart to His heart!

Pastor Joseph preached “Resurrection Power” from I Corinthians 15:45-48. Death is merely a transition from worshipping God in a natural body to worshipping God in spirit, but one day all who die in Him will get a new body through resurrection power! However, God's resurrection power does more than make new bodies for us. He can revive our spirits! We must be careful to not waste away in carnal attitudes. “Wherefore that him that thinketh he standeth take heed lest he fall” (I Corinthians 10:12). Don't be an idolater (anything that we make more important than God is our idol). Don't commit fornication (sexual sin). Submit to God and put worldliness and carnality behind you. Live by the Spirit and walk with God in ethical standards of righteousness and holiness. We must live our life pleasing to the Lord. Don't be respectful of God. We should be a picture of Christ on earth. We may be the only “Jesus” that some people see. We are called to have respect for human life, and especially have respect for our brothers and sisters in the Lord. There's nothing more valuable than a faithful saint of God. We must have faith and be able to give God praise even in the most horrific circumstances in our lives. We are a blessed people. God doesn't want us to murmur and complain. Our brothers and sisters are the body of Christ. Just as we reverence Christ on the cross we reverence Christ in each other by reverencing each other. We are to be one. We must be renewed in the Holy Ghost on a daily basis and walk after the Spirit.
