Sunday AM – Continuation of our Survey of the Book of Acts

Pastor Doug Joseph taught from Acts chapter 26. The English word *apostle* comes from a Greek word meaning “sent” (or sent one), with a connotation of *one who represents the sender in name, power, and authority*. The biblical concept is a being that God has sent on a particular mission. If God assigns you a task, go and accomplish it, or at least try your best. All who have been baptized in Jesus name and filled with the Holy Ghost should be ambassadors representing Jesus Christ in name, power, and authority. God has a plan/purpose for every believer. The word *minister* means servant, and all of us are called to serve in some way. All the original first-century apostles personally knew Jesus during his earthly ministry, except for Paul, to whom the Lord showed Himself by miraculous manifestation after Calvary. Paul was consumed with fulfilling his God-ordained destiny, even if that meant dying. Paul testified to King Agrippa of how he had once persecuted Christians yet was transformed by Jesus. He could not persuade Agrippa to accept truth. Agrippa said Paul could have been set free if he had not appealed to Caesar.

Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached “My Boat = Your Pulpit” from Luke 5:1-11. Jesus needed a place (from which to teach) that was set apart from the crowd. He asked to use Peter’s boat, which was Peter’s very livelihood. Peter agreed, and in so doing, he allowed Jesus to start setting Peter apart as well. *Holy* means “set apart for divine purpose.” When the Lord asks, give Him your very life to become His pulpit. There is but one God and He is the only source of absolute truth, yet He grants freedom of will, albeit not without final judgment. Jesus is the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world, the remedy for sin because of dying in the flesh on the cross. People may walk away from God in this life, but after they die there’s a Judgment Day coming. Choose to be a follower of Jesus. Let Him step into your life. He won’t demand. He will ask. You should treat people the same way. Ask, Seek, and Knock. God doesn’t force us to be in a covenant with Him, He asks us.

Wednesday

Jr. Elder Adena Joseph preached, “Sacrificing the Immediate on the Altar of the Permanent” from Genesis 25:28-34. Sometimes we get so distracted with things going on in our lives that we lose sight of our purpose and are tempted to give up. Esau was distracted with temporary hunger pains so he sold a permanent birthright! We must keep our eyes focused on Jesus. We can’t afford to lose our anointing, our ministry, or our relationship with God—over anything merely temporary. Elder Baron Claypool preached, “Protecting the Sacrifice” from Genesis 15:6-18. Jesus was the supreme sacrifice for man. We must present our bodies as living sacrifices for Him. When Jesus was tempted by the devil, He didn’t give in to him. He rebuked the devil. We must crucify our carnal nature and die out to sin daily. We must not let sin have dominion over us. Protect your sacrifice!


