Sunday AM – Pentecost Sunday

Pastor Joseph preached “The Change” from Joel 2:21-32 & Acts 2:1-4, 14-39. On the Day of Pentecost (Acts 2) they were all in one accord and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost. God is a God of covenant. He requires repentance. When the Holy Ghost comes into us there is a change: God writes His law in our hearts. “This shall be the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel; After those days, saith the Lord, I will put my law in their inward parts, and write it in their hearts; and will be their God, and they shall be my people” (Jeremiah 31:33). The Holy Ghost baptism is for all believers. On the Day of Pentecost (Acts 2) Peter quoted Joel 2 and said, “This is that.” We can enter into the Holy of Holies by a new and living way: the blood of Jesus. When Jesus’ flesh was torn on the cross, the veil was torn in the Temple signifying all humanity can access the presence of God. Now anyone may receive the baptism of the Holy Ghost. We must dedicate ourselves to the Word of God. Once the Holy Ghost comes into us, God internalizes His law in our hearts. We must be determined to change our lifestyle and turn away from sin. You need to repent, be water baptized in the name of Jesus Christ, and receive the infilling of the Holy Ghost.

Sunday PM – Pentecost Sunday

Elder Everett Davenport preached “When They Believe” from John 11:25-26. Pay attention to your beliefs! Our minds have thousands of subconscious thoughts every day. Many of them might be negative. Our brains have many negative experiences stored. We need to consciously, repeatedly, and habitually rewire our brain. We must train our minds to think more positively. It matters what we believe. When you believe, you shall receive. It matters what you hear. Obey what you hear. It matters what you see. It matters what you think. The lame man at the temple was wondering how he was going to make it through another day. Think positive. It matters what we speak. Speak words of life. We don’t need to put restrictions and requirements for God’s direction in our lives. If God be for us, who can be against us? Don’t talk discouragement to yourself. Jesus is the head and He wants each of us to engage in the body ministry. Believe in the ministry that God has called you to do. Be willing to let God use you as He wants to.


