Sunday AM

Pastor Doug Joseph preached "Biblical Authority" from II Timothy 2:15, 3:14-17. God is a speaking God and has given us His Word, the Bible. God is the ultimate author of the Bible. "All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness" (II Tim. 3:16). God inspired godly men *word for word* on what He wanted said and written. We must study God's word, as by it we can become mature so that our character is acceptable to God. The authority of the Bible is supreme. It is necessary and sufficient for salvation and Christian living. We must base our life on God's Word. As believers we have three certain voices in our life: the Bible, godly human leaders, and the voice of the Holy Ghost. Godly human beings have the authority to preach and teach the Word of God, and give counsel based on the Word. The Spirit of God will never tell us anything that contradicts the written Word. There are many improper alternatives that might even be helpful, but the Bible must always be our supreme authority. We must love, believe, and obey God's Word.

Pastor Joseph preached "Risen" from Matthew 9:9-13 & Mark 16:7-18. The Lord's heart is toward those who need healing, deliverance, or salvation. The Lord wants us to walk away from a sinful lifestyle and follow Him. We are serving a risen Savior who can do miracles. The Lord will save, deliver, and heal all who repent and come to Him. God has mercy for all who will follow after Him and is willing to pardon sins. If you have fallen into a pit of sin, you need to rise and follow the risen Savior. Even if the enemy tells you that your life is too messed up, the risen Christ can fix you. Peter denied the Lord three times. The Lord responded not with anger or hatred against Peter but with mercy. God told the disciples to go into the world and preach the gospel unto every one, and that signs (speaking with new tongues, healings, etc.) would follow believers. We serve a risen Savior!

Elder JT Sandy preached "Surrounded by the Savior" from Psalm 125:2. The Lord is *my* Shepherd. We need to take ownership of who our God is and who we serve. CAC honors the memory of Bishop T.F. Tenney

(Promoted to Glory at 84 years of age.)

Tom Fred Tenney, friend to all and longtime UPCI minister, statesman, leader, executive, and General Board member, passed from this life on June 1, 2018. He was born on December 6, 1933, in DeRidder, Louisiana, and he married Thetus Caughron on December 27, 1952.

The Tenneys pastored churches in Monroe and DeRidder, Louisiana. T. F. Tenney served the Louisiana District as sectional



youth leader, youth secretary, youth president, and district superintendent (1978– 2005). During the time he served the UPCI as general youth president (1960–69), the Bible Quizzing program was launched and the first issue of The Conquerors Tread was published. The Partners in Missions (PIM) program, the annual School of Missions, and field and regional conferences began under his leadership as Foreign Missions (now Global Missions) director (1970–75). He was the bishop emeritus of the Louisiana District and an honorary member of the UPCI General Board. In 2005 he was inducted into the UPCI's Order of the Faith. Brother Tenney's life and ministry impacted countless lives, and he will be greatly missed. Please keep the Tenney family and especially Sister Thetus Tenney in prayer as we mourn the loss of this great man of God.
