Sunday AM – Apostolic Faith series

Pastor Doug Joseph taught part 2 of "The Doctrine of Jesus Christ." It is essential to acknowledge the deity of Jesus. His identity is God the Father revealed in flesh. "Jesus" means "Yahweh-Savior" or "Yahweh-is-Salvation." Yahweh (YHWH, at times spelled Jehovah) is God's "I AM" name in Old Testament Hebrew. Jesus is human, but more! His human nature is united with God. Only if Jesus is God does He have power to forgive sin. Jesus is human in every way, yet without sin. On His Father's side He is the Son of God. On His mother's side He is the offspring of David, Abraham, Noah, and Adam. He is physically descended from Mary. He is like us in every way except for the sin curse. Biblical use of "flesh" regarding Jesus means full human nature, not just a body. He is human in soul, in spirit, in will, and in mind. It is "without controversy" great that "God was manifest in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory" (I Timothy 3:16). Jesus was tempted in all points yet He always chose right. His human nature is perfect, sinless. He's the last Adam, the new federal head for mankind to supersede the failed, first Adam. It is essential to acknowledge His humanity. Only as a human could He shed blood for the remission of our sins. As a man He paid for our sins. As God He forgave us.

Pastor Doug Joseph preached "Exceeding Abundantly Above" from Ephesians 3:17-21 and Luke 17:11-19. God is able to give us not only the minimum for our needs, but exceeding abundantly above all we can ask or even think. The latter rain is greater than the former. God's blessings for later are greater than what He has already done in the past. When God tells you to do a thing and you obey, He will bless you exceeding and abundantly above. When one of the ten cleansed lepers returned to give glory to God, he was not just cleansed of leprosy, but also made whole. All the horrific scars of leprosy—gone! We aren't worthy, but God gives us the gifts of repentance and water baptism in His name, by which He forgives us of any sins we've committed, never to be remembered again, and then the gift of being filled with His Spirit. In Jesus we have life and that more abundantly!

Elder Hannah Sandy preached "The Process of Grief" from Matthew 5:4. All negative emotions stem from some kind of loss. At first a person can have denial. You can't accept what happened to you. Next you may get angry. Why did this happen? Then we bargain, as with the Lord. For example, "What I would give to just see that person one more time." Next, you may get depressed, feeling lonely and sad. *You need to let people help you.* We need to be with our church family. We can be sad, cry, talk, love, and mourn with each other. You may go through this process for years but there's nothing wrong with grieving. Over time, with help from your church it gets easier. We are so much stronger together than alone.
