Sunday AM – ongoing “Apostolic Faith” series

Pastor Doug Joseph taught “The Doctrine of Jesus Christ, part 3” starting from Hebrews 3:1, and covering many verses of Scripture. Before God created the universe, He foresaw our sin problem and planned a way of salvation for mankind. Jesus & Calvary were always God’s *logos* (plan) before He created the cosmos. So the human man, Jesus Christ, conceived in Mary’s womb, was destined to die on the cross of Calvary to pay for our sins. Jesus fulfills the roles of Apostle and High Priest. An apostle is someone who God sends with a commission to go and fulfill a certain mission. Jesus’ human nature was sent into the world by way of conception to shed His blood, dying on the cross to pay for our sins. The primary purpose of the Incarnation was to put away sin and destroy the works of the devil. Other purposes were: prepare the Church for His second coming; establish the Messianic kingdom on earth; and judge the world. One cannot articulate the gospel without talking about the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus. The atonement was made necessary by human sinfulness, God’s holiness, God’s law requiring death as the penalty for sin, and God’s desire to save fallen humanity. God’s holiness demands separation from sin. God’s love and mercy provided a substitute. The only possible substitute was the sinless Christ, Jesus. The significance of His death is atonement for sin. He is our Redeemer. Only by the sinless blood of Jesus Christ can man get forgiveness of sins. Jesus tasted death for everyone. He loved us so much!

Sunday PM – special CUF! “Stand With Israel” event

Our guest speaker was Pastor Victor Styrsky, CUF!’s National Outreach Director. The Jewish people have a right to live in their ancient ancestral homeland, Israel. There is no excuse for acts of terrorism against Israel. Israel has the same right as every other nation to defend her citizens from such violent attacks. We need to stand with and pray for the peace of Jerusalem and the inhabitants of Israel.

Wednesday

Jr. Elder Adena Joseph preached “The Call to The Uncomfortable” from Hebrews 13:20-21 & Proverbs 3: 5-6. We are called out of our comfort zone into perilous times—into something uncomfortable so that we can fulfill a higher purpose. God didn’t promise us that life will always be easy, but He did say that He’d never leave us. It’s in our deepest confusion when God provides the answer we need. That’s when He can work the greatest miracles. He wants us to trust Him in our dark hours. Even though you may feel uncomfortable, keep working for the Lord. When you feel yourself being uncomfortable, you’ll find victory by prayer. Elder Rusty Sandy preached “It’s My Desire” from Psalm 27:1-5. Desire is a strong feeling to want something. It should be our desire to live for God no matter what happens in our life. We should desire to pray more, to see souls saved, and a closer relationship with God. Be careful: it’s dangerous to lose your desire to please and worship God. Through trials and troubles our desire should be to God.

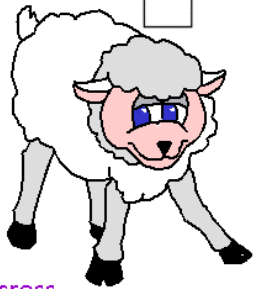
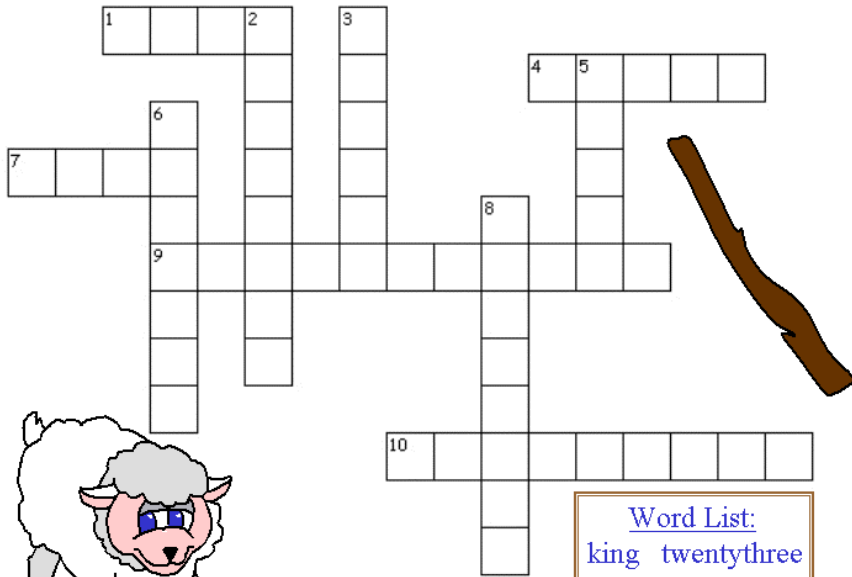

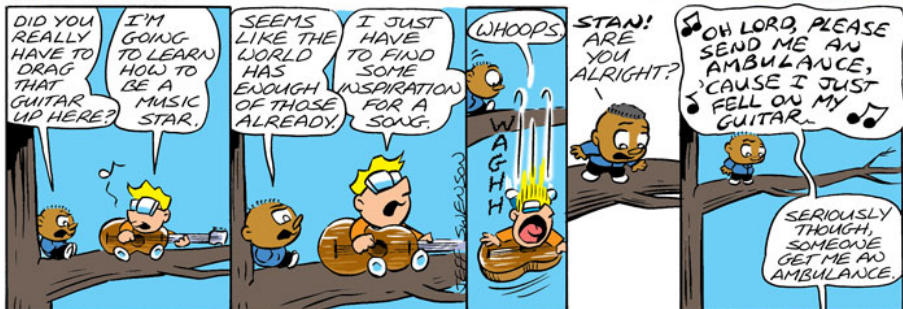
