### Sunday AM – ongoing “Apostolic Faith” series

Pastor Doug Joseph concluded a 4-part lesson, “The Doctrine of Jesus Christ.” We need God’s help to have our hearts transformed. Within our flesh is no good thing. Jesus tasted death for everyone who would choose salvation. His blood sacrifice is potent enough to pay the sin penalty for anyone. Christ died for us while we were “yet sinners” (Rom. 5:8). God desires for all to be saved, but benefits come only to those who believe and obey. One must repent and live a holy life. Jesus’ death made all benefits of salvation available to believers. It reverses the death caused by sin (physical, spiritual, and eternal), bringing healing (physical and spiritual). See Isaiah 53:5. Forgiveness and power over sin are results of His death. Through death He defeated the devil. If we submit ourselves to God we can resist the devil and he will flee. Believers submitted to God can cast out demons. Jesus’ death on the cross reverses all consequences of sin. The burial of Jesus was proof that His death and resurrection were realities. The application of His burial to our salvation experience is through water baptism. Belief in the resurrection is essential for our salvation. We will have glorified, immortal bodies as He had. Significances of His resurrection: it destroyed the power of death and the devil, imparts to us new life in Christ, and assures us of bodily resurrection and immortality. After Jesus ascended on high, a new era began which brought the New Covenant baptism of the Holy Ghost. God and man may have direct relationship with each other. The Spirit of God may reside within us. Jesus is “on the right hand of God” meaning as a man He now has the position of power, authority, glory and meditation.

### Sunday PM

Elder Rusty Sandy preached from Micah 7:8. The enemy likes to rejoice against us when we fail, give up, and quit. Yet God loves us and wants to see us succeed. He wants to preserve us, protect us, and take us to greater heights than we’ve ever been before. “*When I fall, I shall arise.*” When you fall, get back up. That tells the enemy “*I’m not going to quit.*” You must keep getting back up, because God is going to take care of you. God will see you through any circumstance or situation. As you go through trials, people might try to discourage you—but remember, God’s hand is upon you, and you must keep going on. It’s not about how many times you fall down, but how many times you get back up. We must keep pressing forward. You need to give God full control of your life. Trust Him and always get back up whenever you have fallen.

Jr. Elder Caleb Colombo preached “In Jesus Name” from Philippians 2:5-11. When we get baptized in Jesus name, we take upon us the name of Jesus. In His name we can see miracles, signs, and wonders. If we are being tormented by anything, we can be delivered in Jesus name. We need to pray in Jesus’ name for any of our family members who are lost. Do all in the name of Jesus!
