Sunday AM – ongoing series “Teaching the Apostolic Faith”

Pastor Doug Joseph taught part 1 of “The Doctrine of Salvation.” God has only one plan of salvation, based on the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus Christ. We are saved by grace through faith. We cannot earn our way into Heaven. The faith that saves is *obedient* faith. (Faith without works is dead.) Salvation results in deliverance from sin and its consequences. It includes resurrection to eternal life. Jesus is the mediator of a better covenant, superior to prior arrangements. There have been different dispensations, but in each one God has progressively led humanity toward fulfillment of His ultimate plan, always requiring obedience to the then-current arrangement as the expression of saving grace. In our present age we have spiritual fullness. The first aspect of salvation is conversion (turning to God) with elements of grace, faith, repentance, water baptism in Jesus name and Spirit baptism. We are justified (legally declared righteous), regenerated (heart changed), adopted into the family of God, and sanctified (separated from sin/worldliness). This occurs at conversion (new birth), although sanctification is also a life-long process. Event after conversion we still have two natures (carnal and spiritual) until the Rapture of the church. We must walk in the spirit so we won't fulfill the lusts of the flesh. Be led by the Spirit of God!

Sunday PM

Pastor Doug Joseph preached “Never Alone” from Isaiah 7:14, Matthew 1:23, and Romans 8:31. God Almighty stepped into this cosmos in the form of a man to come chasing after us. He went to the cross and shed His blood to pay for our sins. Peter stared out into the storm. When Jesus bid him to come, he stepped out of the boat and began walking on the water. Yet he reached a point where he saw the waves boisterous. He got his eyes off of Jesus and somehow lost his grip on the miracle. Jesus reached down and took hold of his hand. In life when we may feel that we are falling into an abyss, yet God will reach down and lovingly help. The Lord said that He would never leave nor forsake us (Heb. 13:5). He is with His people. He calls the Church His Bride. He longs to fellowship and walk with us. He is our God and we are His people. We are never alone!

Wednesday

Bro. Roger Zimmerman Jr preached “Preparing for Victory” from I Samuel 17:31-37. We are not called to be “one-hit wonders” but to go from victory to victory, because our God is victorious. Our victory comes from Jesus. If God has brought you from struggles to victory He will do it again. God allows us to go through battles to make us stronger. What you face today can prepare you for tomorrow. No matter how hard it gets, just hold on to God – get on your knees, pray, and intercede until the answer comes. Keep in remembrance what God has done for you. At the end of a victory, prepare for the next victory. God can do it again!





