### Sunday AM – on series “Teaching the Apostolic Faith”

Pastor Doug Joseph concluded teaching “The Doctrine of Salvation.” When God fills us with the Holy Ghost He performs a miracle of regeneration resulting in a change of heart within us. However, even then we have two natures (flesh and spirit) battling each other (a fight between our redeemed, inner man and our carnal, outward nature). Redeemed people have the capacity to live right, beyond the law (above it). If we walk after the Spirit we shall live, but if we after the flesh we will die. Jesus made us free from the law of sin and death. Through the miracle of regeneration Jesus works a change in the inner man, making us finally able to choose to do right. We are going to be different because of the Word of God. This change occurs during a process of repentance, water baptism, and Spirit baptism (see Acts 2:38). We are adopted into the family of God. We are adult heirs of God through Jesus. Sanctification and holiness are synonymous, separation from sin and dedication to God. It is instantaneous in some ways, but it is also progressive, a lifelong process of becoming righteous. We must cleanse ourselves from all sin of the flesh. This is salvation by grace through obedient faith. We are the body of Christ. Jesus is the head and He’s already perfect. We must strive to grow for perfection. Our goal is sinless perfection at Christ’s coming. We must be ready!

### Sunday PM

Pastor Doug Joseph preached “More Than Filled” from Luke 4:1 & 14. We need to be filled with the Holy Ghost, yet we must do more than just be filled—we must let the Spirit lead us, and obey what God shows us to do. Being obedient to the Spirit of the Lord is crucial or else the infilling of the Spirit is nullified. “For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the Sons of God” (Romans 8:14). We must be willing to do what God tells us to do. Jesus was full of the Holy Ghost and was led by the Spirit into the wilderness, where He was tempted (tested). He returned in power. We must be obedient and do what the Spirit directs. Jesus was obedient even to death on the cross. In soul winning, we must see beyond outward scars of sin and be concerned about the person’s salvation. Obey the Lord!

### Wednesday

Elder Matt Anderson preached “Out Of Your Comfort Zone” from John 14:9-12. Everyone has comfort zones, so the real the question is whether we will remain in them and be mediocre in our service and accomplishments for God’s Kingdom, or whether we will push to go beyond our comfort zone to do great things for God. Push, stretch, reach, pray, fast, study, witness, beyond and out of comfort zones!
